

# CAP increases van service trips to Chehalis, Vancouver

Starting Monday, Lower Columbia CAP will expand its van service to Vancouver and Chehalis but will discontinue service to Tumwater, the social service agency announced Tuesday.

Service between Longview and Chehalis will increase from two to four trips per weekday, and its service from Longview to Salmon Creek in the Vancouver area will expand from five to six times daily. Current service between Chehalis and Tumwater will be discontinued.

"We are making these changes based on the growing ridership we've seen in recent years and on our riders' needs," said Kelly Wagoner, CAP Transportation Program Manager.

The service costs \$1 each way.
